

Music – We will firstly learn about looping and re-mixing in songs. Secondly, we will be exploring musical theatre and songs used in productions.

Science - This term, our focus in Science will begin with life cycles of animals which will then lead on to looking at reproduction in mammals and plants. We will also explore reversible and irreversible changes including dissolving, burning, filtering and sieving and evaporation. We will then also learn about plastic pollution and the impact it has on our environment.

P.E. – In PE we will be focusing on handball. Our **PE days are Thursday**. Please make sure your child comes to school in non-branded school PE kit. We will also be taking part in forest school on a **Tuesday** where we will be doing activities around the pond area. Please make sure your child has long sleeves and trousers to wear for the afternoon.

English – In English, we will be reading *The General*, *Rooftoppers* and *War Horse*. We will be using these texts as a stimulus to write a variety of genres including instructions, a biography, newspaper report and a 1st person narrative. We will be reading *Mohinder's War* and *War Horse* in our Destination Reader sessions, practicing and applying our reading strategies to comprehend what we have read, ask relevant questions and clarify the meaning of unknown words and phrases.

Computing – In computing, we will be learning about Health, wellbeing and lifestyle and also selection in quizzes.

PSHE – In PSHE, we will be learning about relationships and changing me. We will learn how to solve friendship problems when they occur as well as recognising how to help yourself and others when you feel upset or hurt. We will also think about how everyone is unique and special and how we can understand and respect the changes we see in ourselves and others.

R.E. - In RE, we will be exploring Sikhism and then Christianity, where we will question what is the best way for a Christian to show commitment to God?

Geography – In geography, we will be exploring where our food comes from. We will learn how different foods grow in different biomes, explore how foods have positive and negative impacts on the environment, look at trade and how important it is and describe the journey of food from growing to selling.

Art - In art, we will be exploring masks using our learning about ancient Maya as a stimulus.

DT - In DT we are investigating and making stuffed toys. We will design a toy and then go on to make it using our cutting, stitching and applique skills.

History – During this term, the children will be exploring how the achievements of the ancient Maya impacted their society and beyond that into the wider world. We will learn about the ancient Maya beliefs and how they built their society. We will also make links between what was happening in Britain at the same time.

Maths – In maths, we will be learning about shape including measuring and drawing lines and angles accurately. We will also look at position and direction where we will work with coordinates and lines of symmetry. We will then move on to learn about decimals where we will explore what happens when you add and subtract decimal numbers. We will also learn about negative numbers, converting units of measure and calculating volume.

French – In exploring the French-speaking world, pupils will learn about how to express opinions. We will then learn how to plan a French holiday.
