

Music - During the term, the children will be learning the cornet every Friday with Mr Courtney.

PSHE - Throughout this half term, the children will be considering relationships. They will be looking at healthy and unhealthy relationships and different kinds of relationships. In the second half of the term, the children will be looking at 'changing me'. This includes puberty and being unique.

Art - Within Art lessons, the children will be printing inspired by the artist Sue Brown.
D&T - Through dedicated D.T days, the children will be planning and creating Egyptian collars.

Science - The children will start the summer term by learning about living things and their habitats. We will also look at the digestive system and create different diagrams. Finally, we will end the term looking at food chains and creating simple food chains.

P.E. - During the summer term, the children will complete athletics, cricket, orienteering and tennis.

History - During this term, the children will consider the question 'what changed Britain after the Anglo- Saxon invasion?'

English - Initially, we will look at 'Leon and the place between' where we will work to write a diary entry by exploring descriptive vocabulary when at the circus. We will then look at 'Arthur and the golden rope' where we will plan to write a first person narrative and character description by using an adventure story as a stimulus. We will finally look at 'Libba' and complete a non-chronological report on our favourite role model.

Maths - During this term, the children will continue to look at multiplication and will complete their statutory multiplication times table check in June. The children will also look at money by estimating and calculating different amounts. We will also look at time by converting between analogue and digital.

Computing - In computing this term, we will start by looking at online safety, in particular online reputation. We will then look at sequencing sounds, where the children will use Scratch to code and make sequences.

R.E. - During our RE lessons we will be looking at Christianity and we are asking the question, 'Do people need to go to church to show they are Christians?' We will then look at humanism and answer the question 'What motivates humanists to lead good lives?'

French - In French, we will be looking at fabulous French food. This will include ordering food at a restaurant. We will also look at 'gourmet tour of France', which will include shopping in France and regional foods.

Geography - During this term, the children will consider the question 'What are rivers and how are they used?' They will be looking at the water cycle, how rivers are used and how a river is formed.
