Curriculum Information



English

Our focus texts this term will be Zorilla Giraffa, The Emperor's egg and Rabbit and Bear.

All of these books are about animals and their habitats. The books will be inspiring us to write letters, information texts and reports.

We will be doing phonics, spelling and handwriting every day as well as a daily reading session.

Maths

This term's units will be:

Year 1

- Place value up to 20
- Addition and subtraction to 10
- Shape

Year 2

- Place value to 100
- Addition and subtraction
- Money

History

We are learning about the legend of St. Edmund and the history of Bury St. Edmunds.

Geography

Linking with our science work, we will be learning all about why Penguins don't need to fly. This unit will include learning about cold places in the world.

Science

Year 1 will be learning about Seasonal Change and Materials.

Year 2 will be learning about Animals and their habitats.

Computing

We will be learning about 'The technology around us' and 'Digital photography'

RE

This term's themes are both Christianity units- 'What did Jesus teach us?' And 'Jesus as a gift.'

PSHE

After half term, we will be starting a textiles project on making pouches.

Music

Our music learning will focus on a unit called, 'hands, feet, heart' and after half term, songs for our Nativity show!
