



English

In English, we will be reading Pax by Sarah Pennypacker and The Journey by Francesca Sanna and using these texts as a stimulus to write a variety of genres.

In DR, we will be reading Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo and Wonder by R.J Palacio, and will be developing and applying the different reading strategies and completing comprehension tasks.

Maths

In maths, we will be exploring place value, the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division), fractions, decimals geometry and measures using a concrete, pictorial and abstract approach. Children will be encouraged to reason and apply these skills when problem solving to deepen their thinking and understanding.

History/ Geography

In Geography, we will be exploring how climate change is affecting the world.
In History, we will be learning about WW2 and The Battle of Britain.

Science

- In science, we will be exploring Light.
- We will then move on to learning about the Circulatory system.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning about communication and collaboration and creating web pages.

PE

In PE, we will be practising our foot golf, cross-country, hockey and fitness skills

RE and PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about 'Being Me' and 'Celebrating Differences'

In RE, we will be exploring Christianity and Islam.

Music

In music we will be exploring our Chiranga units: Happy and Classroom Jazz

In art, we will be developing our drawing skills, using pencil, and exploring the work of Hokusai.
