Curriculum Information year 4



English

In English we will be reading on plastic bag by Miranda Paul and using this text as a stimulus to write a formal letter.

In our destination reader lessons we will be reading the girl who stole an elephant. We will practice and apply our reading strategies to comprehend what we have read.

In maths, we will be exploring multiplication/division, measurement, fractions and decimals. The children will be encouraged to reason and apply these skills when problem solving to deepen their thinking and understanding.

We will also have a focus on times tables and we will prompt the children to take part in times tables rock stars twice a week.

<u>History and Geography</u>

In Geography, we will be exploring Florida and beyond the magic kingdom.

In History, we will be learning about Anglo Saxons.

Science

In science, we will be exploring states of matter.

We will then progress on to learning about sound.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning about data logging and repetition in shapes.
