Music

This term, we will be looking at pulse, rhythm and pitch to be able to improve our performance skills using glockenspiels and singing.

Science

We will be identifying and naming a variety of everyday materials. We will also be completing a variety of investigations to find out which materials are the most suitable for different purposes such as, 'What should the 3 pigs use to build a house?'

Later in the term, we will be finding out about how the seasons changes from winter to spring and spring to summer.

English

Each day, we complete our daily supported reading session and learn about phonics in our 'Little Wandle' sessions. In our writing lessons, we will be exploring a range of traditional tales and writing our own versions of them. We will also be working on our letter writing skills and focusing on improving our handwriting and presentation.

Computing

Our first unit is called Digital robots and will involve learning about simple programming. Later in the term, we will be looking at data and information including pictograms including E-Safety and some of the strategies to help stay safe on-line.

Art

We will be developing our sculpting skills using clay. This will involve making our own bowls.
