#### Music

We will be continuing our music sessions by following the topic of 'Bringing Us Together' and 'Reflect, Rewind & Replay' where will learn different songs and play numerous percussion instruments.

### Science

**Plants:** We will be looking at the structure of plants and what they need to survive.

**Light:** We will be looking light exploring prisms, how it reflects and creates shadows.

# **English**

This term, we will continue to practise and develop our writing skills through the context **poetry, narrative and non-fiction**.

Throughout each unit, children develop their knowledge of the key features of each of these types of text, they develop their vocabulary, continue to develop their use of punctuation, and practise their sentence writing.
