Online Safety & TikTok: What Parents Should Know

TikTok is one of the most popular platforms among children and teens — a place to share short videos, follow trends, and connect with friends. But like any social media app, it comes with risks. As parents, understanding how TikTok works and how to guide your child's use is essential.

Top TikTok Safety Tips for Parents:

Explore together: Sit down with your child and explore TikTok together. Use this time to talk about what they enjoy and discuss what's appropriate to share online.

Use Family Pairing: TikTok offers a *Family Pairing* feature that lets you link your account to your child's. This gives you control over screen time, direct messages, and content restrictions.

Set privacy settings: Help your child make their account private so only approved followers can see their content. You can also limit who can comment, duet, or send messages.

Talk about trends: TikTok trends can be fun, but some may encourage risky behaviour. Encourage your child to think critically and avoid participating in anything that feels unsafe or inappropriate.
