Curriculum Information



English

In English, we will be reading *The Journey* by Francesca Sanna and using this text as a stimulus to write letters, a newspaper, arguments and a story.

For Destination Reader, we will be using the text *Cogheart* by Peter Bunzil to practise and apply our reading strategies and to complete written comprehensions about what we've read.

Maths

In maths, we will be revisiting place value, the four operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division), fractions, decimals geometry and measures using a concrete, pictorial and abstract approach. Children will be encouraged to reason and apply these skills when problem solving to deepen their thinking and understanding.

History/ Geography

In Geography, we will be investigating the question 'Who are Britain's national parks for?'

In History, we will be exploring the Mayan civilization.

Science

In science, we will be exploring Electricity.

We will then progress on to learning about Living things and their habitats.

In both topics, we will be refining the scientific skills needed to carry out and conclude a range of different experiments.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning about networks and quizzing.

PE

In PE, we will be learning a traditional dance, working as a team to solve orienteering challenges, playing rounders and practising our athletic skills, ready for sports day.

RE and PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about how to help our world and the processes of growing up.

In RE, we will be exploring Christianity and Humanism.

Art and DT

In art, we will be exploring the work of Gustav Klimt; we will be practising and developing our drawing and collage skills in the style of this artist.

In DT, we will be designing, making and evaluating a product, based on a design brief.

French

Every Tuesday, we are lucky enough to have a French teacher from Stowupland High School in school, teaching us French.
