



English

In English, we will be reading *One Plastic Bag* by Miranda Paul and using this text as a stimulus to have a debate, write a persuasive advert, a leaflet and a non chronological report about an inspirational individual.

Each week in our destination reader sessions, we will be practicing and applying our reading strategies and completing written comprehension about what we've read.

Maths

In maths, we will be continuing to build on our multiplication and division skills as well as exploring fractions and decimals using a concrete, pictorial and abstract approach. Children will be encouraged to reason and apply these skills when problem solving to deepen their thinking and understanding.

Science

In science, we will be exploring:

- States of matter
- Sound

History/ Geography

In Geography, we will be looking at how we can live more sustainably and to end the topic we will make a school action plan of what we can do in school to help the planet.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about the dreams and goals that we have for the future as well as understanding how we can lead a healthier life.

PE

In PE, we will be developing our balance in gymnastics and our rhythm in dance.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning about repetition and data logging.

Art and DT

In art, we will be exploring 3D art which we will be linking to the Anglo-Saxons.

In DT, we will be learning about seasonal food leading up to a day of cooking- more details to follow!
