



English

In English, we will be reading Arthur and the Golden Rope by Joe Todd-Stanton and Libba, which is a true story written about a singer songwriter called Elizabeth Cotton. We will be writing a character description and also retelling Elizabeth's story in our own words.

In Destination reader this term, we will be reading Krindlekrax and each week we will be practicing and applying our reading strategies by completing written comprehension questions about what we have read.

Maths

In maths, we will be continuing to build on our decimals knowledge as well as looking at telling the time, using money, exploring statistics using a concrete, pictorial and abstract approach. Children will be encouraged to reason and apply these skills when problem solving to deepen their thinking and understanding.

Science

In science, we will be exploring living things and their habitats through lots of different scientific enquiries. We have already started this by learning about each child's favourite animal.

French

Bonjour!! After this half-term we will be able to address your friends and family in French as our topic is all about families.

History/ Geography

In Geography, we will be looking at America and then look more closely at the Sunshine State which is more commonly known as Florida. We will be looking at the conservation of turtles and how the climate in Britain differs compared to Florida's.

In History, we will be learning about the Vikings.

RE

In RE, we will be exploring Judaism and Buddhism.

PSHE

In PSHE, we will be learning about the different friendships and relationships that we can have and discovering how we all change as we get older.

PE

In PE, we will be working on our hand-eye coordination through learning how to play tennis, table tennis and rounders. We will hopefully then be able to have a small in class tournament.

Art and DT

In art, we will be exploring and creating some pop-art based on the work of Roy Lichtenstein and Andy Warhol.

In DT, we will be learning about pneumatics.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning about how to take a great photo for a wildlife competition (linking to science). We will also building upon our understanding of repetition and applying this to games.
