## **Curriculum Information**

### **English**

Our focus books this term will be 'Leon and Bob' by Simon James, Pebble in my pocket by Meredith Hooper and Ug by Raymond Biggs.

We will be developing our stamina for writing longer pieces of writing to create creative narratives, explanation texts and to write persuasively. Our Grammar focuses will be conjunctions, prepositions, adverbs and the different types of nouns.

We will continue to use Edshed to practice weekly spellings.

### **Maths**

This term's units will be:

- Place value (Numbers up to 1000)
- Addition and subtraction
- Multiplication and division

In Year 3, we focus on developing speed and fluency with times tables and will practise these regularly.

### **Geography**

This topic will focus on our local area and how it has changed over time.

### **History**

Later in the term, we will be finding out about the Stone age!

### **RE**

This term's themes are 'Would celebrating Diwali bring a feeling of belonging in Hindu child?' And 'Has Christmas lost its true meaning?'

### **Science**

During the first half of the term, we will be finding out about Rocks, fossils and soils.

After half term, we will be learning about the Skeletons and teeth of animals including humans.

### **Computing**

We will be learning about stop animation and computer networks.

### **PE**

Orienteering, Dodgeball and Swimming.  
PE is on Monday and Wednesday Swimming is on Thursday!

### **French**

This term we will be beginning French lessons! We will be learning about greetings and colours.

### **PSHE**

'Who am I and how do I fit?' And 'Respecting similarities and differences.'

### **Art**

This half term, we will be using ancient cave drawings and paintings to inspire us with our drawing and painting skills.

### **DT**

After half term, we will be working on our sewing and textiles skills.

### **Music**

In Music, we will be completing a unit called, 'Let your spirit fly', learning about R&B and Motown music. After Half term, we will be learning how to play the glockenspiel.
